**History:** *Lutheran High Northeast officially opened in August of 1997, holding freshman classes at Grace Lutheran Church and Christ Lutheran School. The original building was completed in 1999 and further additions were added in 2001, 2005, and 2010. Through the years, LHNE has been able to increase the opportunities and programs for the students while continuing to offer a challenging, well-rounded education. LHNE added Agriculture Education in 2019 and plans to add an Ag/Ed workshop and classroom, and an additional science laboratory/classroom by the spring of 2023. LHNE recently celebrated the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the school, graduating over 650 students through those years.*

**Instructional Program:** *Lutheran High Northeast’s instructional program meets and exceeds the requirements of the Nebraska Department of Education and is designed to prepare students academically while promoting leadership development, character building, and an attitude for service. The academic schedule is traditional, offering eight class periods through two semesters. Students are encouraged to participate in the many co-curricular activities and clubs, creating additional opportunities to foster growth and experience while preparing them for their future vocations.*
